Microbial Water Quality Data Volunteer needed ASAP!

The UH HCRI research team has an urgent short term need (starting immediately and lasting two weeks) for data entry support in order to publish microbial data (10,000 data points) collected on Maui in 2010 at Ahihi Kinau, Kihei, Ka'anapali/Kahekili, and Honolua Bay. Here is the HCRI report on the project findings so far. The data shows correlation of increased nutrients and increased microbial populations and increased pathogen concentrations to areas where groundwater carries pollutants that originate in the injection wells and other sewage sources. We have more data and want to analyze it to support publication of the work.
